

## Carriage and Wagon Guidelines

- **Parking**- A flat surfaced parking area must be provided, with dimensions of 90 feet long, 12 feet wide, and 12 feet in height.
- **Path**- A safe path to perform this service is also required. The path must also be flat, free of obstacles, and free of pedestrian traffic. The path must not have deep sand, wet grass or any other terrain that inhibits the mobility of the horses or carriage. An example of an acceptable path would be a route around the block of a low traffic area adjacent to event location, routes on flat roads that circle a park, and routes in a large parking lot or dirt field.
- **Passenger Loading** - We require a minimum area of 25 feet long and 12 feet wide to park and load passengers. This area must always be clear of spectators and awaiting passengers. A line will be established and formed for awaiting passengers OUTSIDE of this loading area. In other words, passengers wait where we start, and not where we park. To not minimize the experience, and to help prevent delays, please inform participants and guests that the rides WILL NOT commence if pedestrians or other obstructions appear in the path or loading area.
- **Payment** – The starting rate is \$2000 - \$3000, but prices will vary depending on distance, availability, and holidays. In some instances, we may be able to charge per ride, depending on the projected amount of traffic at larger events.
- **Decorations** – A cost will be incurred for additional decorations. This amount will vary by type of decoration and the amount of additional time for decorating.
- **Overtime** - Once your rental agreement has expired, there will be a charge of \$300.00 - \$500.00 for each additional hour. This option is only available if we are not booked for another event that follows yours. If another event is scheduled, rides will immediately be terminated at the end of the rental agreement.
- **Departure** – At the end of the rental period, we must be provided a clear path for the movement of the horses and carriage back to the truck and trailer. We can not be obstructed by guests, and the truck cannot be blocked by vehicles which may delay our departure.
